



Good to Great: Why Some Companies Make the Leap... and Others Don't is a prolific book by Jim Collins that describes how elite companies transition from being good to great, and how some companies fail to make the conversion. Contextually, "Greatness" always begins as a productive and determined state of mind, encouraging our lodge, individually and collectively, to reach for the stars, especially in an atmosphere where good is acceptable to most.
